General	SCHOLARSHIP INFO FOR YEAR 13'S:	General	(zRAM)
<p>Information sheets for the Hilda Chenery and Kathleen Mandeno Scholarships will be available from the Administration Office for Students as from Thursday 27th August, 2015. Applications close on Friday 11th September, 2015.</p> <p>The Hilda Chenery Memorial Scholarship is awarded annually to a student of EGGs who wishes to study for a degree in Commerce, Law or Business Management. \$2500 per annum will be awarded to assist with tuition fees and books. The award will be for three years providing the student continues with the same course of study and passes all exams at a level which will enable her to proceed with her degree studies. The student's progress will be appraised annually. To be eligible, a student must have completed a minimum of three years at EGGs, including her seventh form year.</p> <p>The Kathleen Mandeno Scholarship is intended to encourage students to enter the science community and contribute to innovation and research. The scholarship will be awarded to a student of EGGs who wishes to study for a degree in mathematics or any of the sciences, especially the biological sciences, or degrees in related fields such as computer science, bio-engineering or technology. The scholarship will NOT be available to students enrolling for degrees in medicine, dentistry or architecture. The scholarship will be worth \$3,500 payable to the chosen recipient in her first year of study at university, preferably at the University of Auckland. A student who is awarded the scholarship will be eligible to receive a further scholarship in her second and third years at university providing she continues to pursue the same course of study, passes all her exams at a level that will enable her to proceed with her degree and behaves in a way that maintains the school's reputation for producing well-motivated, mature, successful scholars.</p>
