<p>Petition of Erica Whineray Kelly - Provision of intra-operative radiotherapy for breast cancer: Almost 1 in 9 New Zealand women will hear that they have Breast Cancer during their life, with 3,000 women diagnosed each year. Single intra beam radiation treatments for those affected by Breast Cancer removes the need for everyday treatments for 3-5 weeks and would help increase patients' odds of survival. Right now, it is not widely available or accessible to women in public and private hospitals. By signing this online petition which will be sent to the Ministry of Health it will try to make single intra beam treatment easily available for patients who are in desperate need of it.
